Position: Director of Music

Status: Part Time Hourly

Hours: 15 to 20 hours per week

General Purpose Of The Position

In partnership with the Pastor, plan, coordinate and lead music for worship for adults, youth and children. This role will guide the musical life of the church as well as enhance the worship experience of the congregation through the gift of music. This role will use the Music Ministry to support the church's vision of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIP AND SUPERVISION

The Director of Music reports directly to the Pastor. Attendance at the Church Council may be requested. The Pastor, in cooperation with the Staff Parish Relations Committee provides an annual evaluation of the Director of Music's performance.

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

To attend weekly worship services and insure musical accompaniment for the 8:30 am (traditional) 9:45 am (contemporary) and 11:00 am (traditional) services. Special services may be planned (Christmas and Easter).

- . Arrive by 8:00 am on Sundays to set up and prepare for worship
- . To recruit, develop and engage members and musicians to be involved in the worship experience.
- . To consult with the Pastor regarding music programming for all worship services.
- . Actively recruit members for the musical programs.

- . Works with the church staff to coordinate music for special programs.
- . Organize and rehearse musicians and vocalists for the volunteer members of the band at the contemporary (9:45) service.
- . Coordinate presentations for the AV system that are aligned with Sunday sermon.
- . Provide custody and maintenance of property of the music program.
- . Work with pastor and Administrative Council in forming and implementing a yearly budget for music ministry

QUALIFICATIONS

Embrace Christian discipline and theology.

Piano (Keyboard) and Singing skills are required.

Be a skilled musician with experience leading traditional and contemporary worship.
